

From Ornans to Saint-Gorgon-Main (from kilometre 0 to 21)



Vuillafans

Small village full of greenery at the heart of the Loue valley, Vuillafans shows a past full of history. Ramparts of Châteauneuf of the 11th century, ruins of Châteauneuf of the 12th century, stones bridge of the 12th century, mill of the 19th century, each century gives a very characteristic architectural heritage, it's a village built by the winemakers and research for its quality of life.



The little towns of character of the Franche-Comté

Mouthier-Haute-Pierre

Downstream of the source de la Loue, circled by the spectacular Nouailles gorge, a stunning greenery circle this village. This former winegrower town, nowadays known for its kirsch, brings together, around the monastery which gave it birth in the 9th century, picturesque houses build on a complicated network with arched cellar, alongside small street.

Lods

A calm and nice life, the memories of vineyards and barrels filled with wine make all the qualities of this village. The old vine makers' houses of the 15th and 16th century are there, giving a splendid look on the Loue. Today there is no longer vine and only the museum allow you to immerse yourself in this period. This village is classified as one of the most beautiful village of France.

Saint-Gorgon-Main to Levier (from the kilometre 21 to the 52th)

In this portion of the itinerary, 3 villages are linked up on a hilly road alongside pastures and fields. You will cross Ouhaus, Evillers and Septfontaines. in Septfontaines, you can take a shot of adrenalin and feel speed in the karting circuit and paintball of l'Enclos alongside de D41.

The Moine and Renédale viewpoint

They give you impressive viewpoints on the Loue valley. When it's sunny you can perceive away Ornans' chateau.



Notre Dame des Anges

The chapel was build at the end of the 19th century by Ouhaus' parish in gratitude to the Virgin Mary for the protection of the village.

Levier to Ornans (from the kilometre 52 to the 77th)



In Levier, discover the draught horse and the forest life of from the 1900's to today, through sounds and pictures in the draught horse of the Franche-Comté and forest museum.

A few kilometres from Levier, alongside the road, you can perceive through the trees Maillot's chateau où Granges Maillot (private building from the 19th century). Ride a few kilometres and you will arrive in Chantrans, with its typical

heritage of the Franche-Comté: steeple, fountains, trough, laundry. Now you just have to go down during the last 10 km to Ornans.
